Liability insurance Upon arrival, the UV requires trainees certify they – or their home universities on their behalf – have taken out accident and civil liability insurance covering injury to the trainee and civil liability for bodily or material harm caused involuntarily to third parties during the period. The risks to be covered are:

- civil liability for bodily or material harm caused involuntarily to third parties during the period to at least 60,000 euros
- death or injury (to at least 6,000 euros)
- repatriation in case of death (unlimited cover)
- health transport in case of accident or grave illness (unlimited cover)
- transport of relative in case of hospitalisation (unlimited cover)
- and medical costs (to at least 30,000 euros).

This cover costs around 160 euros.

Trainee status

Trainee staff are not considered students and as such are not eligible for certain discounts offered only to Erasmus studies, including on Spanish classes. The additional remuneration we offer seeks to compensate any resulting extra costs. Trainees will receive a university card granting access to library and other services.

Non-Erasmus mobility

Students unable to access Erasmus+ funding can become trainees using the similar mobility programmes, such as the **Turing programme**, providing they are within the framework of mobility agreements signed by Spain or our University.

Non-EU/EEA citizens

Once the learning agreement is signed, we apply for authorisation so you can then apply for a trainee visa, before arrival. This takes at least 4 months. +info You will need to meet further requirements, which incur additional costs:

- A passport valid for at least a year and EHIC or similar health cover.
- Proof of enrolment (or recent graduation) in higher education studies in modern languages or teaching and a criminal records check certificate (in the UK, apply via ACRO), which must be sworn-translated and legalised. +info
- For stays of +6 months, apply for a foreign student card upon arrival. <u>+info</u>

Target language of the conversation groups (native or C2 language certificate).

Candidates must be at least 18 when starting the traineeship.
